- Members received a presentation from the County Bridges Manager on the work of the South Lakeland Bridges Team. The presentation was circulated to Members after the meeting and was noted by the Working Group.
- The Working Group received a Briefing Note from the Traffic Management Team Leader (South Lakeland) which provided an update on the Safer Schools – School Street Initiative - Experimental Traffic Regulation Order in Argyle Street, Ulverston. This is being considered as a separate item on this meeting's agenda.
- The Working Group received a Briefing Note from the Traffic Management Team Leader (South Lakeland) which provided an update of the Divisional Highway Priority Works schemes to be funded via the devolved 2022/2023 Highway Capital budget for South Lakeland. It was resolved that the report be noted and that a separate report would be presented to Local Committee at its meeting on 6th July 2022. This is being considered as a separate item on this meeting's agenda.
- A briefing note was considered from the Local Area Network Manager regarding the delivery of the 2022/2023 Devolved and Non-Devolved Capital Programme within South Lakeland. The Local Area Network Manager guided members through the progress made to date on surface dressing, carriageway resurfacing, footway resurfacing, drainage works, geotechnical works and tree works in South Lakeland. It was resolved that the briefing note be noted.
- A report was considered from the Executive Director – Economy and Infrastructure which gave a Flood and Development Management Update. The report presented an overview of flood and development management activities in the South Lakeland area.
