- 3.1 Scrutiny Management Board on the 1st March 2022 agreed the scope, for a joint Health and Adults Task and Finish Group to focus on the implications of the Health and Care Bill reforms on the integration of Health and Care across the systems in both North and South Cumbria. This Task and Finish

Group will build on the work of the previous Health and Adults Joint Advisory Group.

- 3.3 The first meeting of the Group took place on the 8th June where Cllr Wilson was appointed as Chair. It was agreed that the focus of the Group would be:
- How the Integrated Care Partnership will relate to the Health and Wellbeing Board and other health related organisations.
 - How elected members will engage with the Integrated Care System, and in addition how the voice of the communities will be included.
 - What changes the new Integrated Care System will bring to the Health Scrutiny function.
- 3.4 The next session will be scheduled in July 2022 and will involve taking evidence from a range of witnesses.
