Scrutiny Management Board Briefing from Chair of Adults Scrutiny Board

1.0 Purpose of Update

- 1.1 This report updates Scrutiny Management Board (SMB) on the work of the Adults Scrutiny Advisory Board and any issues and developments that have occurred since the last meeting of SMB.

2.0 Board Meeting Update

- 2.1 Since the last meeting of the Adult Scrutiny Advisory Board was on the 25th June, it considered:

- Promoting Independence Programme
- Safeguarding Adults at risk from abuse and neglect

- 2.2 The next meeting of the Adults Scrutiny Board will take place on the 4th October it will be looking at:

- Shared Lives
- LD & Autism Board Action Plan
- Safeguarding Adults at risk from abuse and neglect

3.0 Additional Scrutiny activity undertaken by the Board

- 3.1 Additional activity undertaken and planned by the Board is noted below:

3.2 Joint Health and Adults Scrutiny Advisory Group

- Cumbria Health Scrutiny Committee and Adults' Scrutiny Advisory Board are having a series of joint meetings to look at areas covering the closer integration of Health and Care Services. The Joint Advisory Group met on the 13th June and focused on Health and Care System Plans for the North and South. It made a number of recommendations to both System Leadership Boards the following recommendations:
- This was the last of the scheduled meetings of the Advisory Group, the scope that was initially agreed by Scrutiny Management Board was for four meetings of the Joint Advisory Group. Members of the Group expressed the view that there was still work to undertake and that the Advisory Group should continue.
- As the parent boards this is a decision for the Adult Scrutiny Board and Health Scrutiny Committee (with ultimate sign off by the Scrutiny Management Board). At it's June meeting the Adult's Scrutiny Board agreed that the Joint Advisory Group continue for an additional four meetings. The Health Scrutiny Committee agreed the same at it's July meeting. An updated scope has been provided to the Chair and Vice Chair of SMB for approval.

3.3 Cumbria Care Developments – The Chair and Vice Chair of the Board have met with the Assistant Director Provider Services regarding the future developments within Cumbria Care. A session for all members of the Board is scheduled for the 25th September at the new Carlisle Care Home.

4.0 Conclusion

4.1 The Board will continue to focus on developments in the People Directorate over the coming few months particularly providing input into the development of emerging policies and new ways of working.
